

Australia was originally named New Holland, but the name was changed by an English naval officer, Mathew Flinders. He explored Botany Bay, where Sydney is now located, and sailed around Tasmania. In 1801 he was put in charge of an expedition that sailed all the way around Australia,



proving that it was a continent. He suggested the name Australia from the Latin word australis, which means "southern." He was only forty when he died, but he had been to more places in his short lifetime than most people ever go.
